Directions to Communicare Office

Bv Car: Take the A4 East from Cemetery Junction and IMMEDIATELY (about 10 yards on) turn left onto Cumberland Road, left again onto Norwood Road and left into the Wycliffe Baptist Church car park. The Communicare office is a modern single storey building attached to the church buildings at the rear and clearly labelled.

On Foot: Cemetery Junction is served by the 17,13,14, 190 and other buses. Coming out of Reading by 17 or 190 and alighting at Cemetery Junction just walk a few yards forward to the Wycliffe Baptist Church, (with other buses walk a few yards back). Facing the church you should see a pathway to the left of the church through an open iron gate which leads to the rear car park. The Communicare office is a modern clearly labelled single storey extension to the right at the back of the church.
